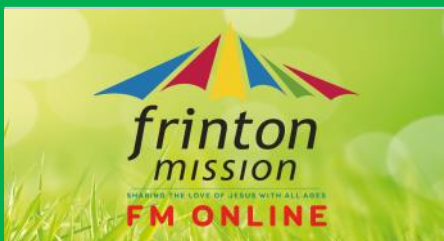
Oasis is now open every week for
