Read Mark 2:23-3:6 and /or watch the video.

God made the world in 6 days. On the 7th day, He rested. Rest was good! This 7th day has always been called the Sabbath. God wanted all of His people to take the Sabbath as a day of rest, a time where no work was done and a time spent in worship to Him.



- 1. Why were the Pharisees angry at Jesus?
- 2. What did Jesus say to them?
- 3. How did Jesus help the man?

God intended for the Sabbath to be a blessing to His people, a day of rest from their hard work. But the Pharisees made the Sabbath all about following the rules, meaning that you couldn't do anything else, even good things. Jesus showed that God's laws were meant to help people, not to hurt them.
