

Parable of the sower



This week we are discovering how we need to grow in Gods word.



Talk about what different things need to grow ie : what do seeds need to grow compared to people?



Read Mark 4:1-20 and /or watch the video.

A parable is a simple story that Jesus told to help us understand and teach us something important.

Back in Jesus' time, farmers would toss or scatter seeds to plant them. This meant that the seeds could go just about anywhere



1. What kinds of ground did the farmer plant the seeds on?
2. Who asked Jesus to explain the parable?
3. What did Jesus say the Seed was?
4. Which soil does God want you to be like?

Although Jesus was speaking about seeds in the parable, the story really applies to people. God is the sower, His Word, the bible is the seed and our hearts are like the soil.

Jesus wants us to read and learn from God's Word and then we can grow. Choose to be like the good soil, hearing and taking Jesus' message to heart and living by it.



Decorate a pot and plant some seeds to watch them grow.
